The Financial Transparency Coalition is aware that there may be concerns for conference participants about travelling to Bangkok for the 8th FTC Conference: Boiling Point to Turning Point. Please refer to the [World Health Organisation \(WHO\) website for travel advice](#) and feel free to reach out to Sargon Nissan: snissan@financialtransparency.org, if you have specific concerns you would like to discuss.

The FTC is monitoring the situation closely and following the advice of the WHO in relation to virus. The WHO declared the Corona Virus to be a Public Health Emergency of International Concern, and on 30 January the International Health Regulations Emergency Committee met and agreed that the WHO should timely review the situation with transparency and update its evidence-based recommendations.

The Committee does not recommend any travel or trade restriction based on the current information available at the current time.
